Our College was re-accredited by NAAC with 'A' Grade in 2013 and conferred with Autonomous Status in 2017.

It is their foresight, support, dedication, enthusiasm, commitment and inspiration that have led the institution. As I share the yearly updates of our activities, I take the modesty to

say that we did our best to do as we have planned and I am proud and grateful to have such a wonderful team of teachers and students who strive hard to achieve beyond expectations to make ourself an acclaimed centre of learning.

With gratitude to our guiding force Nalloor Vettunni Kandan Sastha, and praying for his blessings, here I present our Annual Report for the year 2021-22. This year has been a very eventful one for us. We have made great efforts to transform ourselves and to maintain positivity and high morale to stand up in the hard unprecedented challenging time infected with Covid 19 Pandemic and made it into a successful and fruitful academic year.

We began our academic session 2021-2022 on 21st July 2021 for the B.Ed. second year and the formal inauguration of the B.Ed. first year programme was held on 20th October 2021. For B.Ed. II year, we have 89 students, B.Ed. I year 98 students, M.Ed. I year 5 students, three full time and six part-time scholars for Ph.D. Degree Programme.

ACADEMIC BOARD MEETINGS

The Statutory Meetings of Board of Studies, Academic Council, and Governing Body were held on 22nd July 2021, 13th August 2021 and 29th November 2021 respectively to oversee the various programmes of academic concern.

EXAMINATION RESULTS

Academic excellence is the hallmark of a good institution and our results in the end semester examinations have made us proud.

The results of examination for the B.Ed. (2019-21) and M.Ed. (2019-21) were impressive. The third batch of students under Autonomous stream passed out in June 2021. For the end semester examination held in June 2021 for B.Ed., out of 99 students who appeared, all students passed, 90 students secured first class with distinction and 9 students secured first class. For the second semester M.Ed. examination held in June 2021, out of 4 students who appeared, 2 students passed in first class with distinction.

For the B.Ed. (2020-2022) batch, in their second semester examination held in November 2021, out of 89 students appeared, 18 secured first class with

distinction and 71 attained first class. For the third semester examination held in March 2022 for the B.Ed. (2020-2022) batch, out of 87 students appeared 37 came with first class with distinction, 50 with first class.

For the B.Ed. (2021-2023) batch, for the first semester examination held in March 2022, out of 97 students, 19 secured first class with distinction and 75 got first class. In the M.Ed. (2021-2023) first semester examination held in March 2022, out of the 5 students, one secured first class with distinction and four with first class.

ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS

Induction Programme

In July-December 2021 session, **86** candidates including our faculty and students qualified 11 courses where 1 candidate was the course topper, 6 got Elite+Silver ranking, 17 with Elite ranking, 58 candidates successfully completed the course and in total we received **83** certificates through various courses. One of our faculty member achieved the Discipline Star Award.

During January- April 2022 session, 193 candidates including our faculty and students qualified 15 courses where 2 B.Ed. first year students scored 100% and are the toppers in 1% , 21 candidates achieved Gold medal, 14 got Elite+Silver ranking, 55 with Elite ranking and 131 candidates successfully completed the course and in total we received **221** certificates through various courses. I am proud to announce that Sushma S. and Nivetha S. of B.Ed. I year are the two toppers of SWAYAM-NPTEL examination who scored cent percentage. I am delighted to inform you that our faculty are acting as mentors of our students in assisting them to get through the examinations. Our institution has been listed in "Active Local Chapter List" based on our excellent performance.

As part of National Library Week Celebration, a book donation campaign was also organised from 15th November to 20th November 2021 and the collected books were generously donated to Government High School, Thirunandikkarai.
