**Report on Student Satisfaction survey 2019-2020**

The student satisfaction survey on teaching learning process collected from students revealed the following. 84% of the students reported that they were oriented about both expectations and competencies to be developed on completion of the programme. 58% of the students reported that the teaching of theory courses helped them to become aware about the working of school system in the country. 64% of the students reported that the educational documents available at the institution helped them to understand the educational functioning to a great extent. 56% of the students agreed that they got exposure to multiple mode of teaching learning in the college. 60% of the students reported that they get opportunity to learn through internet-based sources regularly. 40% of the students reported that they could use ICT resources in a limited way for school teaching. 68% of the students reported that the learning activities provided in the college helped them to develop their competencies to become a teacher to a great extent. 56% of the students reported that they were very well prepared for the practice teaching in schools. 49% of the students reported that the orientation given for the school-based internship was very useful and adequate. 82% of the students strongly agreed that their experience in school during internship was very useful. 32% of the students strongly agreed that internal evaluation in the college was relevant and impartial. 54% of the students agreed that the overall qualities of teaching learning and evaluation process in the college were good. 47% of the students reported that the mentoring process in the college helped them to resolve the difficulties in academic and personal matters to a great extent. Majority of

the students reported that microteaching and lessonplan preparation helped them for effective classroom teaching. Majority of the students reported that the development of self-confidence and overcome the stage fear as their expectations which are fulfilled from teacher education program. Majority of the students reported that the time schedule is too long. 68% of the students rated the teaching learning and evaluation process of the college as good.
