**INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL  
(IQAC)REPORT: 2022-2023**

- ▲ We began our academic session 2022- 2023 on July 2022 for the B.Ed second year and the formal inauguration of the B.Ed. first year programme was held on 20<sup>th</sup> October 2022.
- ▲ The Statutory Meetings of Board of Studies, Academic Council, and Governing Body were held on 19<sup>th</sup> July 2022, 6<sup>th</sup> August 2022 and 11<sup>th</sup> November 2022 respectively to oversee the various programmes of academic concern.
- ▲ Induction Programme for B.Ed. students was conducted on 26<sup>th</sup> October and 27<sup>th</sup> October 2022 to orient the students towards teaching, to make them familiarize with the course content, and to help them adjust with the new situations as the new entrants.
- ▲ Bridge course was conducted for B.Ed. students from 28<sup>th</sup> October 2022 to 9<sup>th</sup> November 2022. Eminent Alumni and our faculty were the resource persons
- ▲ Micro teaching classes were conducted from 28<sup>th</sup> November 2022 to 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2022. Different teaching skills were demonstrated and practised. The sessions were handled by our faculty.
- ▲ The Intensive internship programme of students of B.Ed I year (third semester) was held for a duration of 10 weeks starting from 26<sup>th</sup> August 2023. The prospective teachers were allotted in various cooperative schools. The internship programme for M.Ed I year students was held for a period of two weeks from 10<sup>th</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> January 2023 in N.V.K.S. Senior Secondary School, Attoor and N.V.K.S. Vidyalaya, Vettuvanni
- ▲ To empower the students with the skills, knowledge and conviction to participate in democratic and public life, a citizenship training camp was

organized for B.Ed I year students from 19<sup>th</sup> January to 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2023 at Vivekananda Kendra, Kanniyakumari. The camp was inaugurated by Dr. Venukumar, Planning Board Member of Tamil Nadu Teacher's Education University.

- ▲ An awareness programme on Cancer was conducted on 7<sup>th</sup> November 2022. Dr. Ganesh from Saraswathy Hospital, Parassala was the resource person. On 9<sup>th</sup> December 2022, an awareness programme on Group Insurance Policies and Health Insurance Policies was conducted. Officials from LIC interacted with the students.
- ▲ The college has been registered as the Participating Institution under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan and selected five service villages in Kanniyakumari District; Attoor, Pechipparai, Mathoor, Kumarankudi and Pathukani.

- ▲ A python awareness programme was organised for the B.Ed.I year students on 17<sup>th</sup> April, 2023. Research scholars from the Department of Computational Biology and Informatics, University of Kerala, served as resource persons and interacted with students

- ▲ Independence Day and Republic Day were celebrated with all its national pride and patriotism. During these days, the freedom fighters were remembered for their sacrifice with gratitude.

▲ During the period July- December 2022, 100 members including students and faculty appeared for 13 NPTEL courses where 6 members are course toppers, 13 got Elite + Gold ranking, 34 got Elite + silver ranking, 66 got Elite ranking and 36 members successfully completed and in total we received 149 certificates through various courses. One of our faculty members achieved the NPTEL Discipline Star.

This year 20 students of B.Ed II year got placed in various schools in Tamil Nadu.

- ▲ The Career and Counselling Cell organised a skill development programme on 'Interview Skill and Resume Writing' on 17<sup>th</sup> February 2023. The resource person was Prof. Jayakumar, Assistant Professor, Department of English, St. Hindu College, Nagercoil.
- ▲ Periodic NET coaching for M.Ed. students and TET coaching for B.Ed. students are also conducted by the cell through hybrid mode.

In connection with the 'International Day for elimination of violence against women', an award winning movie, 'The Great Indian Kitchen' was screened on 25<sup>th</sup> November 2022, to create awareness about gender equality and a safe working environment.
