As the academic year 2023-2024 draws to a close, our institution's IQAC has successfully relaunched itself in terms of planning, coordinating, and carrying out high-quality educational initiatives that drove our student teacher community toward excellence by envisioning the exalted vision of Gnana, Dharma, and Sneha. Here is a summary of the main points of our scholarly endeavors:

An Over view of the Academic year 2023-2024

Activities

- ▲ We began our academic session 2023-2024 on 11th September 2023 for the B.Ed. & M.Ed second year and the formal inauguration of the B.Ed. first year programme was held on 25th September 2023 and M.Ed I year on 18th October 2023.
- ▲ The Meetings of Board of Studies, Academic Council, and Governing Body were held on 28th December 2023, 12th February 2024 and 27th March 2024 respectively to oversee the various programmes of academic concern.
- ▲ Induction Programme for B.Ed. students was conducted on 26th September and 27th September 2023 to help the newcomers get settled in, acquaint themselves with the course material, and get oriented toward teaching
- ▲ Bridge course was conducted for B.Ed. students from 29th September 2023 to 6th October 2023. The resource people who helped to close the gap between the academic and professional streams were our teachers and distinguished alumni.
- ▲ A Millet Mela and millet exhibition was organised by IQAC of the college on 13th September 2023 joining with Tamil Nadu Food and Safety Department, Kanniyakumari District and N.V.K.S Senior Secondary School, Attoor. More than 100 teams displayed various varieties of food prepared using millets.

- ▲ A workshop on 'Dramatics and Arts in Education' was conducted for B.Ed. II year students on 19 th and 20 th September, 2023. Dr. Saviour Das, Associate Professor (Retd.), St. Jude's College, Thoothoor was the resource person
- ▲ jointly with Agasthya International Foundation organised a workshop on 'Volunteering programme in Science and Mathematics for the students' on 21 st September 2023. Mr. Saravana Kumar J and Mr. Selvaraj. G, Instructors of Agasthya Foundation served as resource persons.
- ▲ A "Life Skill Education Programme" was organised by IQAC for the students on 23 rd September, 2023. Dr. K. Rajeswari, Professor & Head, Centre for Research and Development, N.V.K.S.D. College of Education, served as resource person
- ▲ Our Library has conducted book exhibition on 29th September 2023 as an academic initiative to enhance the love of reading among our students. The Sai Book Gallery, Tirunelveli exhibited more than 2000 books on Education, Psychology, Technology, English and books on Competitive examinations.
- ▲ This year the institution has come up with Memorandum of Understanding with CEAM to foster collaborations and advancement of knowledge in the areas of Education & Research.
- ▲ Online Book Review Series: 'Book Nook: Words and Worlds' through Google meet was organized by N.V.K.S.D College of Education, Attoor, in collaboration with various educational institutions and organizations. The series commenced on October 7, 2023, with Prof. Dr. Geetha Janet Vitus from University of Kerala offering a comprehensive review of 'Inclusive Education', elucidating its conceptual framework and practical implications.
- ▲ A talk on Women Empowerment: Bharatiya perspective, was organised in collaboration with SHODH, South Tamil Nadu on 10th October 2023. Dr. Savitha A.R., Associate professor, Sree Ayyappa College for women was the resource person.
- ▲ To empower the students with the skills, knowledge and conviction to participate in democratic and public life, a citizenship training camp was organized for B.Ed. first year students from 6 th to 10 th November 2023 at Vivekananda Kendra, Kanniyakumari.
- ▲ From November 15, 2023, to November 20, 2023, the Library Readers Forum observed National Library Week as an academic endeavor to foster a love of reading among our students. From November 15 to November 20,

2023, a book donation campaign was held in observance of National Library Week.

- ▲ An awareness programme on TNPSC examination (Group I, II and III) and orientation on online coaching for Competitive Examinations was conducted on 23rd November 2023. Mr. Benjamin Franklin, TNPSC coaching centre, Madurai was the resource person.
- ▲ In connection with AIDS Day, on 1st December 2023, Women's Cell in association with Red Ribbon Club, organized an awareness programme on HIV-AIDS. Dr. Sheeba Jayalal, Dr. Asha and Brigadier Chandra served as the resource persons.
- ▲ IQAC of the college in collaboration with CEAM, AIRIO, CTEF Tamil Nadu and Kerala Chapter organised an international seminar on 'Excellence in Education: Deciphering the Creative Potentials of Knowledge Transfer' on 15th and 16th December 2023.
- ▲ Onam, Christmas, Pongal and New Year were celebrated with all its joy and gusto.
- ▲ Human Rights Day and Bonded Labour Abolition Day were observed. Independence Day and Republic Day were celebrated with all its national pride and patriotism. During these days, the freedom fighters were remembered for their sacrifice with gratitude
- ▲ A workshop on "Earn while Learn" was organised on 11 th January, 2024.
- ▲ A slogan writing programme was held on 24th January 2024 to commemorate Girl Child Day.
- ▲ Organised a book release function on 24 th January 2024. The first print of the novel 'Kaitha Poovu' written by Sahithya Academy Winner Malarvathi was released by film director Lenin Barathi .
- ▲ The SSR for the third cycle of NAAC was submitted on 20 th February 2024 and the visit of NAAC peer team is imminent.
- ▲ SWAYAM-NPTEL Felicitation and Certification Ceremony was held on 15 th February 2024. The Course Toppers were honoured in the ceremony. Dr. Chandraja, C.V, Research Officer, White Memorial Homeo Medical College, was the chief Guest.

- ▲ 58th Graduation Day was held on 24 February 2024. Dr. J. Sacretes, Registrar, Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli delivered the Graduation Day address and distributed the certificates. Students of 2018-2020, 2019-2021 and 2020-2022 academic batches received their degree.
- ▲ Various competitions for women were organized on 7th March 2024, to celebrate Women's Day.
- ▲ An awareness programme on 'Healthier and Safe Motherhood' was held on 12th April 2024, by the Women's Cell.
- ▲ A Four-day educational tour was arranged for the B.Ed. second year students from 18th March to 21st March 2024. Students, along with the staff visited the educationally significant places in Coorg, Mysore and Bangalore.
